REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DECEMBER 2, 2008
5:45 PM

Present: John Campolong, Marilyn Fields, Town-Attorney Tony Floyd, Shilon Green, and Charlie Sutton

Mayor Campolong welcomed everyone and called meeting to order.

Motion to go into executive session to discuss personnel matters made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to come out of executive session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. Murphy.

Motion to accept minutes from Regular Council Meeting, November 5, 2008, made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Councilwoman Fields stated that there was 80 sign-ups at Depot Library at the Christmas Tea was a success. She announced that there would be a Senior Dinner on December 11, 2008 and an Angel Tree Dinner on December 17, 2008. She also reiterated that there would be a Christmas Parade next year.

Motion to change court time with the consent of the judge in January to 2:00 PM made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Councilman Green discussed Town is unable to redo 5-year contract with Dixie Disposal without their consent. Therefore, it is a possible increase in garbage rate to allow Town to break even.

Councilman Sutton discussed paving Walnut Street and the resurfacing of road in front of McBee Elementary. He also discussed cleaning out the old Police Department for the Recreation Department.

Mayor Campolong stated that there would be a Special Election on December 9, 2008 discussed the audit and finances. He also stated the Town Hall parking lot would be paved with concrete donated by the Highway Department.

Town Hall will close noon on December 24, 2009 through December 26, 2008. It will reopen December 29, 2008. It will also close on January 1, 2009.

Motion to adjourn made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.
