REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
APRIL 7, 2009 - 5:45 PM

Present: John Campolong Jr., Marilyn Fields, Tony Floyd-Town Attorney, A. C. McLeod Jr., and Charlie Sutton

Tardy: Shilon Green (5:51 PM)

Mayor Campolong called the meeting to order.

Motion: to enter into executive session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-7 (a) (2) for update on pending legal matters made by Councilman Sutton; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion: to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilman McLeod. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. Corley.

Motion to approve minutes from Regular Town Council Meeting made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. Discussion: Mayor Campolong stated to add the time the meeting began on minutes. All were in favor.

Motion to pay \$425 for e-Civis made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Councilwoman Fields stated that there would be a breakfast for local businesses in the town on April 8, 2009 at 8:15 AM. At a later date, something would be done for the local service providers. She also discussed that the flag will to be replaced at the Depot Library/Museum.

Councilman McLeod spoke with Clyde Brice about the Storm Water permit to construct the ball fields. DHEC had questioned some things and Mr. Brice replied to them. He met with Alligator about moving some water lines. Alligator declined until other matters could be worked out. He unsure about seeding the ball fields this year.

Councilman McLeod did the second and final reading of Ordinance 2009-1 to request that Chesterfield County accept dedication of East Cedar Avenue Extension and Holley Avenue.

Motion to formally give Chesterfield a copy of all the deeds to the property of the right-a-way, a letter requesting them to maintain the roads, and to accept Ordinance 2009-1 made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Councilman McLeod spoke to some land owners concerning the convenience center. He stated that maybe by next year a grant could be put in to move the convenience center closer to McBee. Hopefully, it could be moved closer to school and it could educate the students the importance of recycling.

Councilman Sutton stated that the only street that is not paved in McBee is Walnut. A grant was approved for \$208,000 to pave that street. No complaint about Streets and Sanitation.

Councilman Green is excited about Walnut being paved. He also stated that the Town put in for a grant to cement the sidewalks.

Mayor Campolong reiterated the cementing of the sidewalk. He spoke on the Stimulus Plan. He discussed the JAC grant and COPS grant that was being worked on. Council is doing everything they can to meet the needs of the Town even though revenues are being cut.

Motion for Councilman McLeod to be added to Water & Sewer committee made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to send letter in favor of renaming Hwy 145 to U.S. 220 made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Town Hall will be closed on April 10, 2009.

Motion to adjourn made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.
