REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 2, 2010 - 5:45 PM

Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was present and typed minutes.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters and legal matters for contractual matters made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields.

Invocation made by Rev. Michael Parnell; the Pledge of Allegiance immediately followed.

Motion to accept minutes for February 2, 2010 made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Mayor Campolong. Discussion: Councilwoman Fields made a correction to the minutes that should have been "Woodmen of the World." All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong spoke on discussion on public comment. He reiterated that if anyone would like to speak at the meeting, he or she would need to sign up 24 hours in advance with Town Clerk.

Chief Hayes stated that engineers will reevaluate speed zone in front of the high school. He also stated that there is an issue with train stopping and not allowing traffic to pass. He also stated that he is still reviewing applications for full-time and part-time police officers.

Councilwoman Fields stated that County Councilman Frank Plyler will repair door on Depot Library as soon as there is change in weather. She also announced that work has begun on the Depot Library roof.

Motion to purchase 2 ID badges, 2 ID wallet clips, ID Chief Badge, and 4 belt badge holder for \$601.46 made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Sutton. Councilman Green voted present. Mayor Campolong, Councilman Sutton, and Councilwoman Fields were in favor.

Jamie Wayne announced that Recreation Department was accepting baseball and sign-ups; this year there would be only 3 ball fields to use.

Mayor Campolong added that the PRT grant will be submitted within the next week and a half.

Councilman Sutton expressed concerns about building a holding pond for the paving of Walnut Street. Billy Scott, SCDOT, assured him that the issue will be discussed at the next SCDOT meeting.

Mayor Campolong stated that the inside of the Depot Library needed repair after the roof is repaired. He reported that the town will be awarded a block grant for \$31,000. This grant would replace some items at the town's facilities to make them more energy efficient. The grant should be allotted within 3-4 weeks

Motion to adjourn made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.
