REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 4, 2010 - 5:45 PM

Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was present and typed minutes.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, legal matters for contractual matters, and to include Chief Hayes made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. McCluney; pledge immediately followed.

Sam Carver, President of Chesterfield County for Pee Dee Coalition, introduced Lisa Hyatt, Director of all the counties for the Pee Dee Coalition. She spoke on the different services that are offered. She also spoke on the kind of issues dealing with victims in the McBee area.

Motion to approve minutes from Regular Town Council Meeting on April 6, 2010 made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Marilyn gave an update on the erecting of the flagpole.

Motion for Council to reappoint Gloria Ingram Calder to the Election Commission made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Mayor Campolong. Discussion: Councilman Green abstained from voting. Mayor Campolong, Councilwoman Fields, and Councilman Sutton were in favor.

Councilman Sutton questioned water issues.

Councilman Green stated the sidewalk project should begin by the end of the month; the Walnut St. project should also be finished by the end of the month.

Councilman Green read aloud Ordinance 2010-01 to amend the Code of Ordinance No. 5.211, Burning Trash, Bonfires. Chapter 5 Article II. He reiterated that the picking up of leaves and limbs will not be eliminated.

Motion to accept first reading of Ordinance 2010-01 made by Councilman Green; seconded by Mayor Campolong. Discussion: It needs to be clarified the town will give out permit but will not responsible for the burning. State guidelines and regulations will need to be followed. All were in favor.

Councilman Green hopes to have something on the dog ordinance next meeting.

Motion to amend agenda to discuss storage building near tennis court made by Councilman Green; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.

Town Attorney, Tony Floyd, spoke on issues concerning ownership of dirt in which a building sits on that is located near the tennis court on Eleventh Street (Food Bank).

Motion to give permission to Tony Floyd, Town Attorney, to do an abstract of title search on the property made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong spoke about various items on the 2010-2011 budget that were discussed from the Work Session. The total budget for the General Fund and the Utility Fund is estimated to be around \$700,000. He explained how monies to be potentially received from the county and state were included.

Motion to accept first reading of budget for fiscal year 2010-2011 made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong announced that Town Hall will be closed on May 31, 2010 for Memorial Day; the National Day of Prayer will be at McBee United Methodist Church on May 6, 2010 at 12:30 PM.

Motion to adjourn made Councilman Green; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.
