Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was present and typed minutes.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, and legal matters for contractual matters made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. Allen; pledge immediately followed.

Motion to approve minutes for October 5, 2010 made by Councilman Sutton; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong reported for Councilwoman Fields. He announced that on December 4 there will be a Christmas Parade, Tour of Homes, and Christmas Tea at the Depot Library. He also announced the Senior Dinner on December 12 and the Angel Tree Dinner will be December 13. The Town Hall will be closed on November 25-26 for Thanksgiving Holidays.

Chief Hayes gave a report on the Police Department. He stated that since January the Police Department has issued 757 citations and warrants for different violations. He asked Council to purchase 2 walkie-talkies from Communications Technology, LLC in Chesterfield for \$805.

Motion to purchase 2 walkie-talkies made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Councilman McLeod stated that the silt fence was up and he has the price for seed for the Recreation Park.

Councilman Sutton questioned Mr. Bobby Blackwell (Alligator Rural Water) about why town is being charged for locates since Alligator installed water meters.

Town Attorney Tony Floyd read aloud Ordinance 2010-02 to set franchise to Time Warner NY Cable LLC

Motion for First Reading of Ordinance 2010-02 to set franchise to Time Warner NY Cable LLC made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Sutton. Councilman McLeod abstained from voting. Mayor Campolong and Councilman Sutton were in favor.

Mayor Campolong stated that the Public Hearing and second reading of the ordinance to set franchise fees for Time Warner Cable will be at the next meeting. He stated that he received audit reports. Council will have a Work Session to review the audit. He stated that Brenda Ratliff from the Chesterfield Economic Development Board wanted to meet on November 9 beginning at 2:00 PM to discuss strategic planning. He also stated that a notice would be placed on door to advertise the old fire siren was for sale and bids will be taken.

Motion to adjourn made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.
