REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
OCTOBER 5, 2010 – 5:55 PM

Present: John Campolong Jr., Marilyn Fields, Tony Floyd (Town Attorney), Shilon Green, A. C. McLeod Jr. & Charlie Sutton

Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was present and typed minutes.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, legal matters for contractual matters, and to include County Councilman Frank Plyler made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman McLeod. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. Donald Williams; pledge immediately followed.  
County Councilman Frank Plyler swore Councilman Green and Councilman McLeod into office.

Motion to approve minutes as written for September 8, 2010 made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. Councilman Green sustained from voting due to him not being at the last meeting. Mayor Campolong, Councilwoman Fields, Councilman McLeod, and Councilman Sutton were in favor.

Bill Todd, Captain of the Charlotte Fire Department, inquired about the old fire siren at old Fire Department. He wanted make a donation to acquire siren to make a relic out of it.

Councilwoman Fields stated that she along with Chief Hayes interviewed a third part-time police officer.

Chief Hayes recommended that Tracey Wilson, former Deputy Sheriff from Kershaw County, to be hired as part- time police officer.

Motion to hire Tracey Wilson for part-time police officer made Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.

Nola Alford and Willie Mae Roary announced the Senior Dinner will be on December 12 between 4 PM or 5PM. Angel Tree dinner will be December 13. Letters will be sent out to all churches the first week in November.

Councilwoman Fields announced the Christmas Parade will be December 4 beginning at 4:30 PM. Time will be discussed at next meeting.

Councilwoman Fields is looking into working on Donor Board. The Donor Board will work on receiving donations for Recreation Park. She is also looking for flags to replace the flags donated from American Legion.

Motion to accept Internal Control Policy as written made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.

Motion to purchase winter gear (4 jackets and 8 long sleeve shirts) for \$932.00 to be used by the police officers made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Councilman McLeod stated that the silk fence was put up. He stated that the seed for sod would be sowed and soil would be brought in for the ball fields. He stated that he didn't hear anything from Alligator about the moving the water line. Mr. Bobby Blackwell told Town Attorney Floyd to get in touch with Mr. Spencer. He formally thanked Nola Alford and Willie Mae Roary for a well done job for the community. He also stated that the issue with CSX has gotten better.

Councilman Sutton would like to have a Fall Festival next year.

Mayor Campolong stated that all air conditioning installation had been completed and soon we should start receiving energy saving results. He announced that the Town has received a \$5000 grant that would be used toward the Recreation Park. He stated that the audit was 95% finished. He stated that there will be a Work Session. He also stated there are some roofing problems at the old pharmacy and there is a potential buyer.

Councilman Green stated that Time Warner Cable is interested in coming to McBee. Town Attorney Floyd prepared an ordinance that will grant Time Warner Cable the right to provide cable services in the Town limits with 5% franchise fees. Councilman McLeod would like to do some research with Sandhills Telephone before a decision is made.
