REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 8, 2010 – 5:55 PM

Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was present and typed minutes.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, legal matters for contractual matters, and to include Chief Hayes made by Councilman Sutton; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman McLeod. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Councilwoman Fields; pledge immediately followed.

Motion to accept minutes for Regular Meeting on August 3, 2010 made by Councilman Sutton; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Councilwoman Fields announced that there would be a 9/11 Flagpole Dedication Service on September 9 at 6:00 PM; the Woodmen of the World donated the flagpole and a new flag.

Chief Hayes gave an update on the Police Department.

Motion made by Mayor Campolong to hire new police officer; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong stated that Time Warner wants to come into town with a cable system. They had requested approval from town and county. Council would like to see what county will do first.

Chief Hayes introduced Council to Greg Block, the new police officer.

Councilwoman Fields stated that the American Legion will be taking down the American Flags after 9/11 and will be put back up for Memorial Day. She along with Councilman Sutton are looking into replacing them for the fall and winter months. She also stated that the first meeting on Christmas Parade will be soon.

Councilman McLeod has received engineering plans for Recreation Park. He stated that Mar Mac Disposal had donated the silt fence material, Mar Mac Wire had donated poles, and McLeod Farms will donate the labor of installing it. He estimated the donations to be around \$12,000. He stated that Alligator Rural Water had been asked to consider moving the water line but no response had been received. He spoke on issues with CSX. He commended the Police Department.

Town Attorney Tony Floyd inquired a response from Bobby Blackwell about what Alligator Rural Water was going to do with the water line. Mr. Blackwell thought that the line was capped and would be left in the ground.

Councilman Sutton congratulated the newly re-elected Council. He spoke on issues concerning the lawn mower.

Mayor Campolong commended the newly re-elected Council. He expressed approval of the hard work from the Council. He also gave an update on the replacing of the air conditioners at the Town Hall, Scout Hut, and Depot Library from the State Energy Grant.

Councilman McLeod formally thanked the citizens for re-electing him.

Motion to amend the agenda to re-enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the contract of old medical office building with Rev. Corley made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to adjourn made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman McLeod. All were in favor.
