Reports:

Administrator Terri King

The Town has received a payment from FEMA for Hurricane Matthew in the amount of \$6,437.33.

Mayor John Campolong

The Town had submitted claims for the roof of the library, the roofs of the dug outs at the Complex Baseball Fields, and for the debris cleanup. The roofs of the dug outs were covered by insurance and were not eligible for FEMA reimbursement. The closing papers have been signed, but we may have more funds coming.

Council Member Beulah Bolton

Letters have been mailed to the local churches asking for any interest in adopting one of the Town's entrance signs. I have not received any responses at this time.

I'm still receiving concerns about the lack of street signs in the town. This is something that we should take care of.

Who is responsible for keeping the roads clean when the grass is cut by the DOT? The debris left in the roads present a hazard and could cause accidents. They should be required to clean the debris from the road. I will check with the DOT and find out what can be done about this.

Council Member Marion Stephens

There was a shooting on East Walnut today, where a bullet entered a house and went through the door, cabinet, wall and window. The owner of the house could have been hit by this bullet. There have been concerns about the traffic on Walnut and the activity on this street. I feel that this area should be patrolled more often.
