

Chapter 5: Building and Fire Prevention


Article 2: Fire Prevention

Amending the Code of Ordinance No.5.211 BURNING TRASH.BONFIRES
Chapter 5, Article II, by amending to read.

It shall be unlawful to burn any trash, wood, or to have a bonfire within the corporate limits without first obtaining a permit from the Town Hall.

- a. Before any permit is issued, someone from the Town of McBee will check to make sure conditions are favorable for burning. The clerk will inform the person obtaining the permit of certain standards to go by. Someone has to be with the fire at all times until it is completely out. Water will have to be available before a fire is ignited and all fires will need to be out by dark.
- b. The Town of McBee will not be responsible for anyone who ignites a fire; the permit is only to inform the Town the location and property owner. Whoever ignites the fire will assume all responsibility.
- c. The Town of McBee reserves the right to refuse anyone the right to burn if conditions are not favorable.
- d. To burn on Saturday, permit will need to be obtained on Friday. There will be no burning on Sunday.
- e. Any person who shall fail to meet all criteria before and after they ignite any fire, upon conviction, be charged not more than \$500.00 or 30 days in jail.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 22nd day of October, 2002 that Chapter 5, Article II is amended.
