At our May 24<sup>th</sup> Special meeting the Council passed a motion to rescind the May 1<sup>st</sup> motion on mobile homes that had a moratorium on any additional mobile homes coming into the Town and to begin enforcement of the 1994 Mobile Home Ordinance, which stipulates that permits would be required to place a mobile home in the town. This motion become effective on May 24th.

At the June regular Council meeting the council formed a citizen's committee to have a public hearing to gather information on revising the mobile home ordinance, with the hearing scheduled this Thursday, July 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. at the McBee High Cafeteria.
